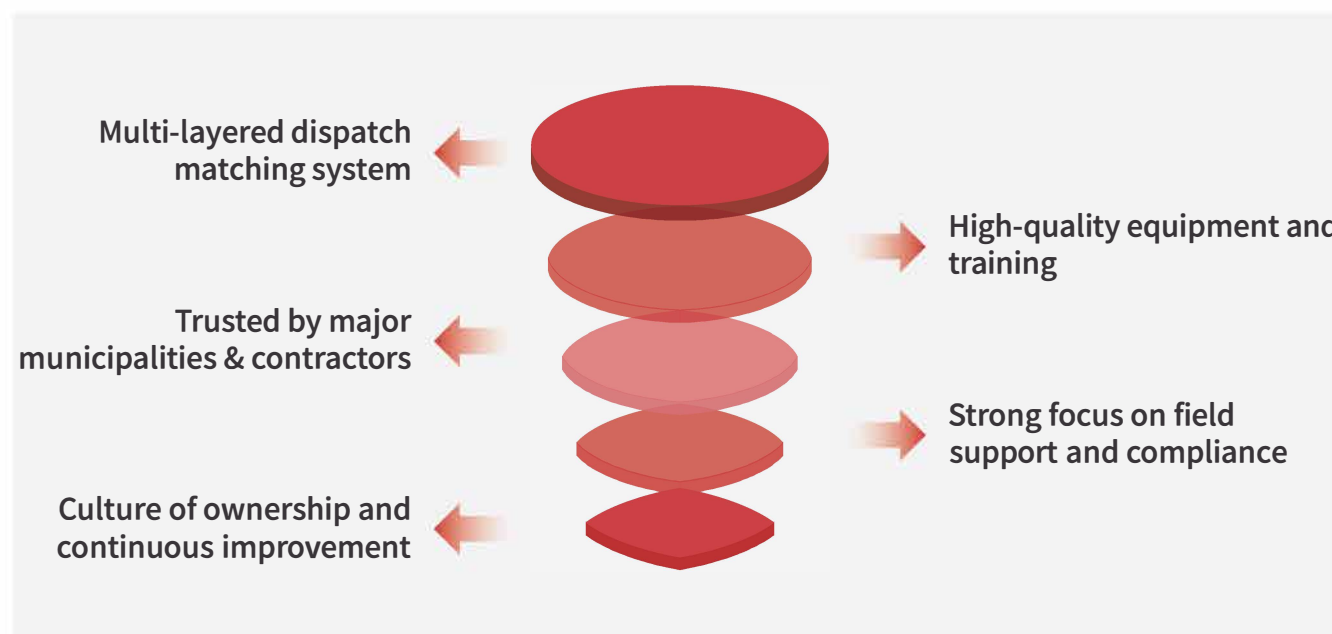
Industry Overview

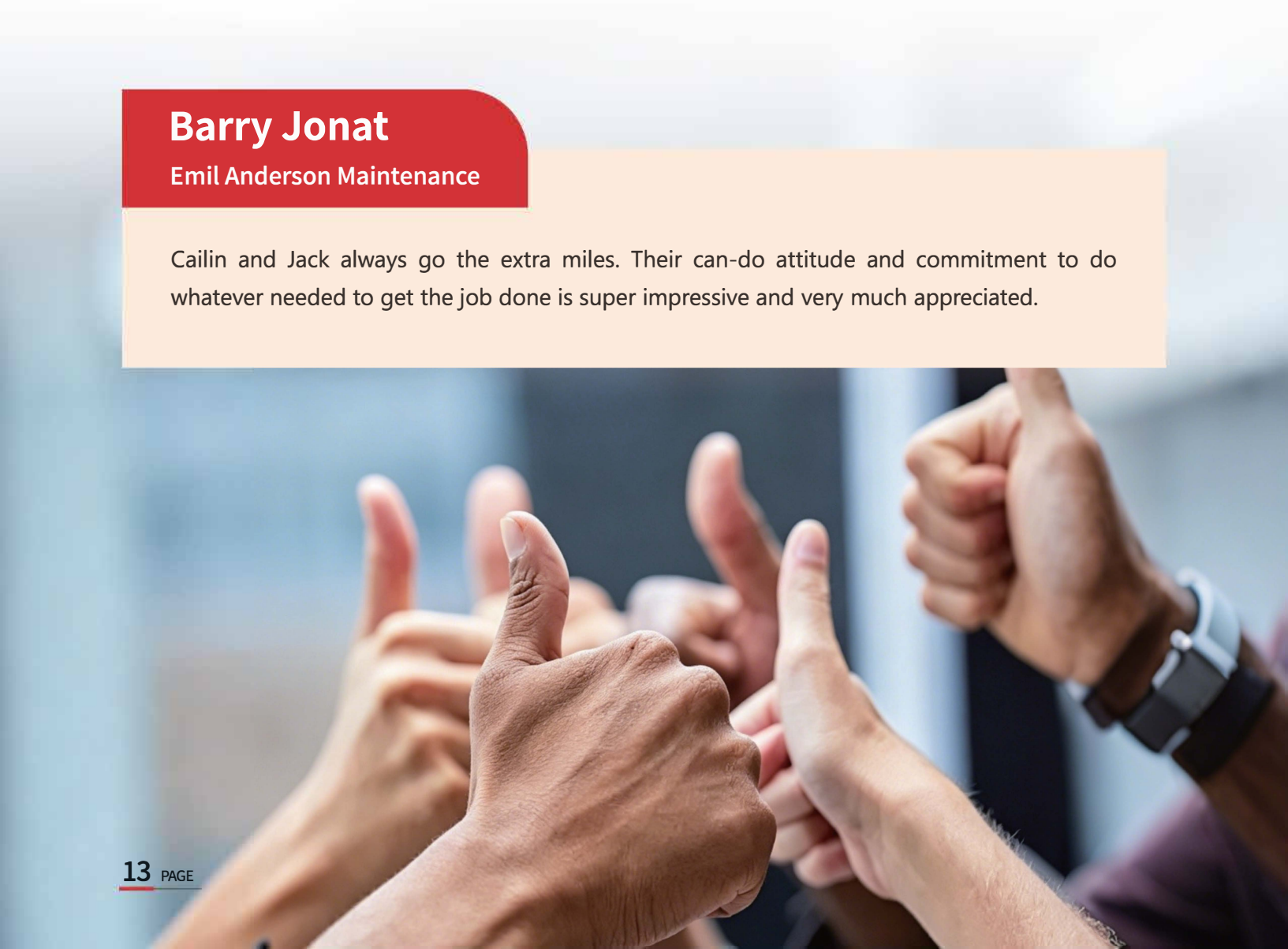
